5. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or in the case of a corporation, must either be executed under seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised in writing.

To be valid, this form of proxy, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of such power or authority, must be deposited at the Company's branch registrars in Hong Kong, Tricor Secretaries Limited of 26th Floor, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time of the meeting or any adjournment thereof.

In the case of joint holders, any one of such joint holders may vote at the meeting, either personally or by proxy, but if more than one of the joint holders are present at the meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons whose names stands first on the register of members in respect of the relevant share shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
8. The proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the meeting in person to represent you. Completion and deposit of this form of proxy, however, will not preclude you from attending and voting at the annual general meeting if you so wish.
